

5 things about swim safety

Memorial Day weekend is a convenient time for many families to open up their pools for the summer. In recognition of National Water Safety Month in May, keep in mind these tips to keep children safe in and near pools.

1 Always watch your children when they are in or near a pool or spa. Never take your eyes off children in the water.

Designate a pool watcher and practice "touch supervision" with children under the age of 5. This means that an adult is within arm's length of the child at all times.

2 Learn how to swim and teach your child how to swim, but don't rely on swimming lessons, life preservers or other equipment to make children water-safe. Nothing replaces adult supervision.

3 Don't leave items out, such as toys, which might attract a child into the pool and pool area.

4 Install a fence around the perimeter of the pool that is at least four feet in height. Use self-closing and self-latching gates. Install alarms that can be heard inside the house and other areas away from the pool that will sound when a child has entered the pool

perimeter. If a child is missing, always look in the pool first. Seconds count in preventing death or disability.

5 Never use a pool with its cover partially in place, since children may become entrapped under it. Always remove the cover completely.

ROCHESTER Flower City chosen for bone density study

Rochester Clinical Research has been selected to participate in a research study to determine the effects of certain oral contraceptive pills on bone development in healthy, teenage girls. More than 1,300 young women between the ages of 12 to 18 are expected to take part in the study.

Rochester Clinical Research (RCR) is currently recruiting young women who have regular menstrual cycles and are not currently taking birth control pills. During the one-year study, participants will have five medical visits, take study medication and receive three bone density tests. Participants will be compensated for their time and travel expenses.

Pet shelter closing to make way for new location

WHAT IT IS Four-Legged Friends, an animal shelter on Penfield Road, is closing temporarily. The rental space is closing as the shelter looks to build a new, permanent shelter, said Karen Pullano, shelter coordinator.

BACKGROUND The shelter has been open since 2006, and operating on Penfield Road since 2008. It began as an organization for feral cats, spaying or neutering them and releasing them into the wild. The shelter has focused on arranging adoptions of

strays and feral cats. Pullano said the shelter would take "problem" cats and give them a change of pace and environment. The shelter was started after Pullano and a few friends rescued 40 cats from a barn near Corning. The owner was threatening to poison the felines, so Pullano and friends stepped in to help. Sixteen of the 40 cats were rescued and given new homes; the remaining were too sick. The group of five decided to start Four-Legged Friends. The shelter is now closing,

temporarily, and the cats that are in the shelter need to find homes. An adoption "sale" of sorts will take place this weekend, offering the cats at a \$25 adoption fee. Four-Legged Friends needs to find homes for 28 cats. Any cats not adopted will be placed in foster homes, Pullano said. The shelter also helps dogs, having taken in nearly two dozen recently. There are four left in foster homes — two pomeranians and two dachshunds. The shelter will be open for the adoption event at 1694

Penfield Road from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday, May 28, noon to 3 p.m., May 29 and from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday, May 30. For a link to see the adoptable animals, head to Penfield-Post.com.
